holidays 방학 (방학은 보통 연속된 기간의 휴가(holiday)를 의미하므로 복수형으로 쓰임)

B: The holidays are for relaxing, but **what matters is** that you still have responsibilities.

8.2 What matters is ~ 중요한 것은 ~이야.

A: But I always finish my homework on time. **There's nothing like** a bit of pressure to get things done!

8.15 There's nothing like ~ ~만 한 것은 없어.

B: Son, **is that what** you think?

8.12 Is that what ~? 그게 ~인 거야?

A: Well, it works for me. **What did you do with** your school holidays, Mum?

B: I **used to** do my homework first and then play.

A: That's the reason why you're always so stressed. **It's no wonder** you always get annoyed with me.
