A: Excuse me? I could have worn something lighter, but I didn't want to freeze to death. But aren't you cold?

11.13 I could have p.p. 난 ~할 수도 있었어.

B: I couldn't be happier to wear this, but it seems like people are whispering about us.

11.7 I couldn't be happier to-V ~하는 것이 난 더할 나위 없이 기뻐.

2.25 It seems like ~ ~인 것 같아.

A: They weren't laughing at us; they were probably laughing at you. That's not underwear, is it?

B: It can't be underwear. I don't really like being the centre of attention.

like being the centre of attention 주목받는 것을 좋아하다 (긍정적, 부정적의미로 다 쓰임)

A: The bottom line is, this date is ruined. I can't believe you wore that!

11.3 The bottom line is (that) ~ 중요한 건 ~라는 거야.

B: I don't want to go through this awkwardness anymore.

A: Fine, let's just end this then. Good luck with that underwear.

(People are watching them argue with interest.)
