

회화력이 급상승하는 구동사 3

인간관계 & 소통 (Relationships & Communication)

1. reach out (to someone) (~에게) 연락하다

to contact someone, especially in order to offer help, show concern, or communicate feelings



e.g. I'm thinking of reaching out to him.

(3/7) I'm thinking of V-ing 난 ~하려고 생각 중이야.

2. back (someone) up (누군가를) 지지하다

to support someone by agreeing with them or helping them in a situation, especially during a discussion, argument, or difficult time



e.g. I'm willing to back you up if things get tough.

(3/26) I'm willing to-V 난 기꺼이 ~할 거야.

3. **catch up (with someone) (~와) 밀린 수다를 떨다**

to talk with someone you haven't seen for a while in order to exchange news or updates about each other's lives

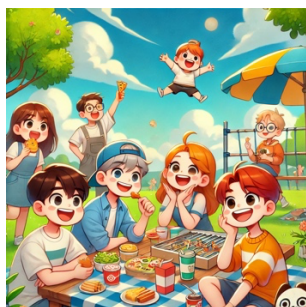


e.g. What do you say we **catch up** with each other this weekend?

(3/17) What do you say ~? ~하는 게 어때?

4. **hang out (with someone) (~와) 시간을 보내다**

to spend time relaxing or enjoying yourself with someone, often in a casual or informal setting



e.g. That would be fun to **hang out** with them again.

(3/3) That would be ~ 그거 ~이겠는데.

5. **come over (집에) 놀러 오다**

to visit someone at their home, especially for a casual or social reason



e.g. Would you like to **come over** this Friday night?

(3/10) Would you like to-V? ~할래?

6. **open up (to someone) (~에게) 마음을 터놓다**

to talk more freely about your thoughts and feelings, especially things that are private or difficult to share



e.g. That's why it's hard for me to **open up** to people.

(3/5) That's why ~ 그래서 ~인 거야[거구나].

7. **make up (with someone) (~와) 화해하다**

to become friends again after an argument or disagreement



e.g. What if she wants to **make up** with me?

(3/15) What if ~? 만일 ~이면 어찌지?

8. **ask (someone) out (~에게) 데이트 신청하다**

to invite someone to go on a date, especially in a romantic context



e.g. What makes you **ask** her **out** now?

(3/13) What makes you V? 왜 ~해?

9. **turn (someone) down (~를) 거절하다**

to refuse an offer, request, or invitation from someone



e.g. You don't want to **turn** him **down** too harshly.

(3/25) You don't want to-V 넌 ~하지 않는 게 좋을 거야.

10. **bring (something) up 화제를 꺼내다**

to start talking about a subject or topic in a conversation



e.g. What I'm trying to say is that you shouldn't have **brought** that **up**.

(3/16) What I'm trying to say is (that) ~ 내가 말하고자 하는 건 ~라는 거야.
