사고 & 학습 (Thinking & Learning)

1. find out (외부 정보를 통해) 알아내다

to learn something that you did not know before, usually by getting information from someone or somewhere else



e.g. I was wondering if you could find out what time the meeting starts.
(4/1) I was wondering if you could V ~하실 수 있을지 해서요.

2. figure out (고민 끝에 스스로) 알아내다, 이해하다

to understand something or solve a problem by thinking carefully



e.g. I'm having a hard time figuring out how this app works.
(4/10) I'm having a hard time V-ing ~하고 있기가 힘들어.

3. look into 조사하다

to examine the facts about a situation or problem in order to understand it or solve it



e.g. I'm going to look into the issue this afternoon.

(4/2) I'm going to-V 난 ~할 거야.

4. come up with 생각해내다

to think of an idea, answer, or plan, especially after considering or trying hard



e.g. I was just about to come up with a solution.

(4/8) I was just about to-V 내가 막 ~하려던 참이었어.

5. **fill in (양식을) 작성하다** – 영국식표현이고 전체작성, 일부기입 불문하고 사용.

영국에선 fill out 은 쓰지 않음

to write the necessary information on a form

cf) 미국식 - fill out (전체 양식을) 작성하다, fill in (양식의 일부를) 기입하다, 빈칸을 채우다



e.g. **I'm ready to fill in the form now.**

(4/15) I'm ready to-V 난 ~할 준비가 됐어.

6. **write down (단순한 기억, 기록을 위해) 적어두다, 메모하다**

to write something on paper (or a device) so that you don't forget it

cf) write up (생각과 형식을 담아) 작성하다, 글을 쓰다



e.g. **I just wanted to write down your address.**

(4/18) I just wanted to-V 난 단지 ~하고 싶었어.

7. go over 검토하다

to carefully examine something, especially to check details or understand it better



e.g. If I'm going to go over the details, I need more time.

(4/3) If I'm going to-V, 내가 ~하려면,

8. brush up on 복습하다

to improve your knowledge or skill in something you have learnt before



e.g. I can't wait to brush up on my English before the trip.

(4/21) I can't wait to-V 난 빨리 ~하고 싶어.

9. catch on (뒤늦게) 이해하다; 인기를 얻다

to begin to understand something, especially after a delay; to become popular or fashionable



e.g. I don't know why it took me so long to catch on.

(4/23) I don't know why ~ 왜 ~인지 모르겠어.

10. think over 곰곰이 생각하다

to consider something carefully before making a decision or forming an opinion



e.g. What are you planning to do after you think it over?

(4/12) What are you planning to-V? 넌 뭘 ~할 계획이야?
