

회화력이 급상승하는 구동사 9

행동 & 결정 (Actions & Decisions)

1. **make up one's mind** (고심 끝에) 결심하다

cf) decide 결정하다 (일반적인 선택의 뉘앙스)

to decide something after thinking carefully



e.g. Let me know when you make up your mind.

(9/5) Let me know ~ ~을 나에게 알려 줘.

2. **give in to (sb/sth)** ~에 굴복하다, ~을 마지 못해 받아들이다

to stop resisting and allow yourself to be controlled or influenced by someone or something



e.g. Don't even think about giving in to them.

(9/8) Don't even think about V-ing ~에 대해서는 생각도 하지 마.

3. **crack down on** 강력히 단속하다

to take strong action to stop something, usually illegal or harmful



e.g. It's no wonder the US **cracked down on** vehicle imports from China.

(9/4) It's no wonder (that) ~ ~인 건 당연해.

4. **break into** 침입하다

to enter a building, car, or place illegally and often by force



e.g. Do you know who **broke into** the shop last night?

(9/2) Do you know ~? 넌 ~을 알아?

5. go ahead 진행하다

to start or continue doing something



e.g. Is it true that they will go ahead with the project?

(9/23) Is it true (that) ~? ~라는 것이 사실이야?

6. do away with (더 이상 필요하지 않아서) 없애다, 폐지하다

to get rid of something, especially because it is no longer needed or wanted



e.g. It's all about doing away with unnecessary stuff.

(9/6) It's all about ~ ~이 가장 중요해.

7. **walk away** (힘든 상황을 외면하고) 떠나다

to leave a difficult or unpleasant situation instead of dealing with it



e.g. I never thought she would **walk away** so easily.

(9/17) I never thought ~ ~라고 한 번도 생각해 본 적 없어.

8. **hold on** (잠깐) 기다리다

to wait for a short time



e.g. It bothers me that you won't **hold on** for a moment.

(9/10) bothers me (that) ~ ~라는 것이 신경 쓰여.

9. look out for (sb/sth) ~을 조심하다

– watch out 과 같이 '조심하다'라는 뜻인데 watch out 은 '일시적 주의' 상황에서 잘 쓰이고, look out 은 '지속적인 주의' 상황에서 잘 쓰임. 그리고 look out 은 특정 방향이나 대상을 보면서 조심하라는 뉘앙스이기 때문에 for 를 붙여서 look out for 로 자주 사용됨.

to be watchful and pay attention in order to notice or avoid a particular person or thing, often over a period of time.



e.g. Don't forget to look out for cars when you cross the road.

(9/11) Don't forget to-V ~하는 거 잊지 마.

10. keep up with (sb/sth) ~을 따라잡다; 뒤처지지 않다

to move or progress at the same speed as someone or something; to stay informed about the latest developments.



e.g. It remains to be seen whether I can keep up with them.

(9/30) It remains to be seen whether ~ ~인지는 두고 봐야 해.
