사회 & 변화 (Society & Change)

1. **carry out** 실행하다, 수행하다

to do something that was planned or asked for



e.g. The bottom line is that we need to **carry out** the plan.

(11/3) The bottom line is (that) ~ 중요한 건 ~라는 거야.

2. **ramp up** (규모·속도·강도를) 대폭 늘리다

to increase something a lot in amount, speed, or level



e.g. I'm not in favour of **ramping up** spending.

(11/10) I'm not in favour of N/V-ing 난 ~에 찬성하지 않아.

3. **take off** 급성장하다

to become successful or popular very quickly



e.g. Even though we started late, the channel **took off**.

(11/18) even though ~ 비록 ~이지만

4. **step up** 나서다, 강화하다

to do more or act more strongly because it is needed



e.g. I had no choice but to **step up** and lead the team.

(11/9) I had no choice but to-V 난 ~할 수밖에 없었어.

5. **stand up for** ~을 지지하다, 옹호하다

to support or defend someone or something



e.g. **Even if** things get messy, I'll **stand up for** you.

(11/19) even if ~ 설령 ~이더라도

6. **root out** 근절하다

to find and remove something bad completely



e.g. I'm known for **rooting out** inefficiencies.

(11/2) I'm known for N/V-ing 난 ~으로 유명하지.

7. fend off 막아내다

to stop something harmful from reaching you



e.g. I'm sorry to say, but we failed to fend off political attacks.

(11/27) I'm sorry to say, but ~ 이렇게 말해서 미안하지만, ~

8. phase out 단계적으로 폐지하다

to stop something slowly in stages



e.g. I took it for granted that the programme would be phased out.

(11/21) I took it for granted (that) ~ 난 당연히 ~일 거라 생각했어.

9. **bring about** (변화를) 일어나게 하다, 초래하다

to make something happen



e.g. I'd love the opportunity to **bring about** meaningful change.

(11/26) I'd love the opportunity to-V ~할 기회가 생기면 정말 좋겠어.

10. **give back** 환원하다, 되돌려 주다

to return something to its owner or to society



e.g. I couldn't be happier to **give back** to my community.

(11/7) I couldn't be happier to-V ~하는 것이 난 더할 나위 없이 기뻐.
